MAP TO RIVER QUEEN BOARDING SITE

The River Queen's home port is Jeffersonville, Indiana, but the captain has graciously agreed to board us on the Kentucky side of the river. The boarding site is at the north end of Fourth Avenue, to the west of where the Belle of Louisville sternwheeler is docked. Boarding time: 7 pm, Friday, October 19. There are at least three ways to get there:

- (1) Take the Toonerville Trolley marked "River Front" north on Fourth Avenue; it will take you to the wharf at Fourth & the river.
- (2) Take the Toonerville Trolley marked "Galt House" north on Fourth Avenue; exit at the Galt House, and take the stairs at the north end of the sidewalk outside the Galt House to the wharf (there is a blue and white sign which reads "Stairs to Belle of Louisville Wharf").
- (3) Walk north on Fourth Avenue past the Galt House and take the stairs to the wharf.
